A. Fall 2024: Board of Trustees' approval by early November 2023 for CSU GE and IGETC submission Courses that are DCCC approved on October 12th will be sent to BOT for their November 14th meeting. Scott and Kevin will submit all courses seeking CSU GE and IGETC approvals around November 15th.

B. Common Course Numbering: New Developments

John shared a PowerPoint with the committee on CCN. They are still on the implementation date of Fall 2024. The Academic Senate committees agree they will not be ready by that date and are submitting a petition to the state to have it extended. There will be more information on their October 18th meeting. GE and major prep course is going to have a template created. There are similarities and difference from the CID descriptor. The similarity is the template will have all the elements of course outline of record. The difference is they are creating an course outline of record and will ask colleges if they have a course that meets their CORs needs. There will be an approval process and they are hoping if a community college's course lines up with the template, it will be an automatic approval. Otherwise, it will be a manual approval. They identified what will be identical, things that will be considered equivalent and the things that are going to be considered common. They agreed there is going to be an identical course subject, number, title, description, and requisites. Every community college must have those items identical. Content and objectives are going to be considered equivalent.

C. AB 928 Updates: Cal-GETC, ADT, and Title 5/AA GE

There will be an update to the Cal-GETC handbook, minor revisions to the criteria description to defined areas. Every student that declares an interest in transferring will be put on an ADT track. There is not going to be a Cal-GETC for STEM, but there are going to have 6 units of wiggle room for the STEM fields. The power point was sent to the committee via email.
