 - i. John attended the Curriculum institute in July. They gave confirmation on Cal-GETC and revisions to the Title V for the AAGE. They're still discussing the changes to AAGE; the state has not officially approved the changes.

- VIII. Tech Review Clarification/Updates: (Guy Dadson, Technical Review Chair)
 - A. Guy will send notice to reps of 6-year review soon
- IX. New Prefix for Drone Program: [DTAS]: (George Bonnand, Tech and Engineering) TABLED
 - A. Jay Seidel would like to create a new prefix (DTAS) for the drone program. The Drone program has been immensely successful at Fullerton college. As a result, there's been a lot of demand for this program. They started using the tech prefix but would like to use its own prefix for just Drone courses. There was concern that the prefix selected will cause confusion for students since this prefix does not give any indication it is for drone courses. Jay let George know the reason he is choosing to use this prefix is because it is used in other colleges. The agenda item was TABLED to give Jay an opportunity to come to the curriculum committee with a brief on the prefix change.
- X. <u>UC Audit, ASSIST and Catalog Strategy</u> (John Ison, Curriculum Chair)
 - A. The articulation office had an audit from UCTCA of courses listed in ASSIST and in our catalog. There were some discrepancies particularly in course titles. The discrepancies were in the course titles mainly based on punctuation. HR reached out to John about a course title that was not allowing them to pull a report they needed. Certain punctuations are not recommended and are causing issues in Banner based on programming issues. A resolution is needed, and articulation, curriculum committee, curriculum team and catalog/district will work together to solve the problem.
- XI. AA GE: Revision Strategy, Paralegal GE Requirements and ABA: (John Ison, Curriculum Chair)
 - A. There must be revision to the AA GE for Fall 2024, as this is the deadline that community colleges must add Ethnic Studies area F to the local degree. Adding this area will add 3 units to the AA GE. The discussion concerned either keeping the multicultural graduation requirement, or phasing it out, therefore replacing the multicultural graduation requirement with Ethnic Studies area F. Further discussion will continue.
 - B. The paralegal GE the aba dictates what exactly could be part of general education or a paralegal program. The curriculum committee would like to add the paralegal GE in CNET to have record of it. Gary will work on that request and get back to the committee for feedback.
