- **IX. Drone Program Items**: (George Bonnand, Tech and Engineering)

Jay Seidel provided the curriculum committee with a report for a new Drone Technology Department. They would like to create a new prefix (DRON) for the Drone program that now uses the TECH prefix. Feedback from students and FC's curriculum committee suggested that DRON would be a better prefix than the original choice, DTAS. The administration supports the development of the Baccalaureate program, but the state requires an Associate degree to offered at the college first. Jay would like the AS degree to be fast-tracked for the purpose of submitting an application in January for a Baccalaureate degree. John mentioned if we keep the courses with the prefix TECH, the committee would be able to fast-track the AS. We can change the prefix after the AS is approved.

Rosie Kar and Amber Gonzalez from the Ethnic Studies department attended the meeting. They would like to change some of their prefixes from a general ETHS prefix to specific prefixes. They would not eliminate ETHS; there would be an addition of prefixes to their department. Scott is waiting on feedback from UC OP and the Chancellor's Office to make sure the prefix change does not affect area F or area 7. This agenda item was tabled to wait on the feedback.

 - This approval process allows discipline faculty to modify programs (degrees and/or certificates) to accommodate the addition or subtraction of courses from outside the program's discipline. Guy suggested limiting the creation of this revision to the leadership of the curriculum committee (John, Guy, and Heather). The process still includes tech review, and involve faculty in revision, but if we were to limit it to the leadership team, we wouldn't have anyone creating this proposal by accident. John provided the curriculum committee the criteria for this program revision via email. The curriculum committee approved this suggestion.
