- C. Fast-track FSA (state discipline code) approvals: MSU
- D. Chair requests permission from the Curriculum Committee to use the approval process "Program Revision for Course Impacts" for title change of ARTH 155 F and ARTH 155HF, FROM Western Art History 15th to 20th Century TO Western Art History 15th to 21st Century. Program impacts (as required courses) include Studio Arts ADT, Art History ADT, Art AA and Art History AA. C-ID approval requires course revision for 2024, and the lack of an approved C-ID descriptor jeopardizes degree offerings. The only impact to programs is the revision of several characters. No other program changes are required. However, there are a few programs within the discipline (ARTH), so special CC permission is required.

A. Updates re: AA GE, Cal-GETC, Common Course Numbering

Cal-GETC standards handbook will only have a few changes in the Cal-GETC areas that weren't previously

investigated. Effective Fall 2025, all of the active ADT narratives and TMCs must be updated to reflect Cal-GETC. They will not need to be sent through the approval process. The link to the chancellor's office with the updated TMC templates were sent to all division reps. If the ADTs themselves are being

A representative is needed for the program mapper taskforce. They meet every 4th Monday of the month 1-3pm. 295 out of the 300 have already been mapped so not much work if left. The work the taskforce is currently doing is reviewing possible exception to the program maps.

- XI. <u>Title 5 AA GE revisions: Discussion Continues</u>: (John Ison, Curriculum Chair, and guests) Jennifer Combs (Counseling) and Pamela Lewin (PE))
- XII. Faculty guests Jennifer Combs (Counseling) and Pamela Lewin (PE) provided a thorough justification for maintaining "Lifelong Learning and Self-Development" and "Physical Education." Currently, "Lifelong Learning..." is Area E, and "Physical Education" is a Graduation Requirement. Since this was the second session in which the curriculum committee discussed this mandatory Title 5 revision of the AA GE, many questions remained, and many options were considered. A motion, a second and a vote occurred, in an attempt to narrow the focus of the discussion. Given the results of the vote and "the sense of the curriculum committee," there needed to be further consideration of every possible angle as the AA GE is revised.
