Guy recorded all subject codes listed in CNET as he revises the six-year review schedule. Subject codes will be added to the calendar on the website, curriculum.fullcoll.edu. He also reminded all the division reps to participate in technical review.

# XI. <u>Title 5 AA GE revisions</u>: (John Ison, Curriculum Chair, and possible guests)

Faculty from various divisions discussed the importance of the Multicultural and Physical Education graduation requirements. Participating from Social Science: Sergio Banda, Martha Roberts, Leonor Cadena, Jodi Balma (not present, but whose statement was read aloud by Kelly Nelson-Wright). Participating from PE: Garrett Campbell and Phil Austin. Participating from Counseling: Gail Rasch. Participating from Humanities: Deidre Hughes. The curriculum committee received their feedback, and committee-focused discussions on the AA GE revision will continue in February 2024.

# XII. <u>ADTs and Cal-GETC: Plans</u>: (John Ison, Curriculum Chair)

The state Chancellor's office requires revision of ADT narratives and TMCs in order to include Cal-GETC unit calculations. As of Fall 2025, CSU GE and IGETC will not be factored into unit calculations. John asked reps to inform him which ADTs will remain active through 2025, and which will be revised in 2024 or 2025. ADTs in the former category will have narratives and TMCs updated for Cal-GETC before Spring 2025. These updates will be treated as fast-track approvals. ADTs in the latter category (those undergoing revision in 2024 or 2025) will be processed as major program revisions in the usual manner. These revised ADTs must use the new Cal-GETC narratives and TMCs.
