rep wanted to clarify counselors are not the ones who approve the students for credit for prior learning, that would be ultimately the faculty who approves the students. The agenda item will be TABLED so the rep can go back to her division on possibly revising the language. **TABLED**

John provided the committee with feedback from his division on the possible AA GE pattern to consider based on other's recommendations. The committee discussed other feedback they have received. Gary provided the committee with a handout of the programs, the GE requirements and how many total units it will take the students to complete. The discussion continues. To narrow down the discussions the committee voted on:

Title 5 GE requirement only: 4 votes. Title 5 GE requirements plus 1 area added: 1 vote. Title 5 GE requirements plus 2 areas added: 1 vote. Title 5 GE requirements plus 3 areas added: 3 votes.

At the April 3rd meeting the committee will narrow down the discussion on only the Title 5 GE minimum requirements and Title 5 GE requirements plus 3 areas added.
