## X. Continuous Enrollment and Catalog Rights: (Thydan Huynh, Counseling)

Thydan brought a first read proposal to the curriculum committee to revise the catalog statement concerning catalog rights. It expands the definition to be more inclusive and student friendly. The rationale for the proposal is students may need to take courses at other colleges due to various reasons. It also encourages students to return and complete their degree at Fullerton College. The language was shared with the committee via email and provided during the meeting. This document was a first read and will be brought back next meeting on November 6<sup>th</sup>.

# XII. Associate GE: Areas 1-6 to contain Cal-GETC-approved courses only? INFORMATION ITEM (NO VOTE)

- B. This will be placed on the November 6 CC discussion agenda, as well. It will be considered an action item, unless the committee would like more time to consider the options.

As Fullerton College revises its associate degree pattern, questions have been raised about possibly requiring courses to have Cal-GETC approval in order to qualify for Areas 1-6. Providing the committee with an idea of what a Cal-GETC list would look like, we shared the 2024-2025 catalog's list of IGETC-approved courses. (Virtually all IGETC-approved courses will "migrate" to Cal-GETC as of Fall 2025.) Since Cal-GETC will be the singular transfer pathway, and will replace CSU GE in Fall 2025, we reminded the committee that there are around 115 courses on CSU GE that are not on Cal-GETC. An "all-Cal-GETC" GE list would remove CSU GE-approved courses and other courses. Some argued that it would not serve students not planning to transfer. Committee reps provided many arguments against removing courses not approved for Cal-GETC. More discussion on this topic is necessary after DCCC meets on November 5.
